Word on the Street

The construction for the 500,000 SF Monarch Beverage Headquarters has started with completion set for next spring. This will bring 449 full time jobs, and a \$40 million dollar investment to our City. Additionally it should employ as many as a 100 construction workers.



September 13, Keep Indianapolis Beautiful, and the Redevelopment Commission sponsored a tree planting at 56th St & Pendleton Pike. Approximately 50 volunteers planted 60 trees. This is a continuation of the effort started last year on 56th St between Post & Franklin.



O'Neal Steel recently purchased the former H & H Steel Building at 56th & Mitthoeffer. They will eventually employ 130 employees, and have already added several million dollars of new equipment. They are starting up quickly and feel they will soon be at capacity.



The new Pendleton Pike is shaping up. The new intersection of 42nd St, Sellers, and Pendleton Pike is open and is a huge improvement. Several stretches of the north side of the new highway are complete and give a hint of how attractive the new roadway will be. Construction continues to be on schedule with the ultimate completion date of November 2009.
