Lawrence Township's Relay for Life Set for June 6

Relay for Life is American Cancer Society's major fundraiser. We do not just focus on one type of cancer, like breast cancer, instead we take on the disease in its entirety. We Celebrate, Remember and Fight Back for 24 hours, June 6th and 7th at Belzer Middle School.

Celebrate, Remember and Fight Back (CRFB) is our Mission Statement so-to-speak; Celebrate our Survivors, Remember those we have lost to Cancer and Fight Back the rest of the 364 days of the year. This year, since it is Relay's 25 Year Anniversary, we decided to add a 25th hour to the Relay and that 25th hour is called 'Show Your Hope.' We plan on spending our 25th Hour in April in which we hope to bring the entire Community together to paint the town purple. Business, schools, churches, Police, Fire and citizens all can all Show Their Hope by wearing purple that day, putting purple balloons up at work, Purple lights etc. That evening we will all join together for a 1 hour Relay around the Lawrence Central HS track and have a ceremony to cap it off. We are proud that Lawrence has been Relaying for 18 years and the original Relay in Central Indiana and now we are even prouder to say Lawrence is an All-American Relay (in which the Mayor deserves.)

The Fight Back Champion Team of 2008 was Shut It Down (Ingersall Rand Team) in which they had the most Tell-A-Friend Forms, Picture a Cure Forms and ACS/CAN's Tell A Friend Forms are to help woman remember to get their annual mammograms (if caught in earliest stages it has a 90+% chance of being cured) and the ACS CAN is a membership in which we sign up to lobby to our legislators for Bills to benefit fighting Cancer. Insurance companies covering a prosthetic because of Cancer, smoke free work places, for insurance companies to pay for a PET scan that scans the entire body instead of a general area. Shut It Down did a great job last year and in a close second was Screwballs of America.
